Desire2Learn, now known as just D2L, Inc., announced the renaming of its flagship learning environment to *Brightspace by D2L* at their annual conference. This reflects a **change in name only** - there has been no change to the login URL or course shells. While you may see the Brightspace name in documentation, we still refer to the learning platform as D2L.
