What's New in D2L?

1. 'GRADES' ALERTS:

a. Due to latency in transmission, students using the mobile Pulse App may inadvertently receive grade updates when instructors make a course inactive to enter grades. It is best practice to hide the grade item(s) to prevent students from unintentionally receiving grade updates via Pulse.

b. If you "hide" grades when entering scores, two conditions cause a hidden grade item's value to become Grades visible to students. When **both** the 'Final Calculated Grade' column is released, and the 'Display how final grade was calculated to users' option is selected on the 'Org Unit Display' tab in **grade settings**, students are able to view the score of a hidden

grade item after clicking the calculator icon that shows in the student grade area. The simplest workaround is to make sure the 'Final Calculated strategies to assist faculty in course development.

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221 Montgomery Hall 814-393-1226 Grade' column is **NOT** released (visible) until you have completed grading the assignment.

- **2. DISCUSSIONS**: Assessing Discussion threads in GRID view with a D2L Rubric will result in an error when publishing. As a workaround, assess discussions in 'thread view' while using an associated rubric.
- **3. REMINDER:** The new 'Quiz Builder' experience will be "on" by default in the **MAY 2020** release. Click the 'tab' on the **Add/Edit Questions screen** to turn on/(or off) to test out the new quiz experience.
- **4. WIGGIO**: Due to tool end-of-life, Wiggio will be **removed** from the Communication menu in D2L courses **December 13, 2019**. If you have content that you would like to save such as 'conversations', files/folders, events, links, polls, etc., please reach out to the LTC for instructions.
