ReadSpeaker Implemented in D2L

In our continued work to help you improve student



outcomes, ReadSpeaker, text-to-speech technology had been added to the content area of D2L. The ReadSpeaker suite of text-to-speech solutions increases efficacy and extends the reach of online content by instantly creating an audio version of html, pdf, doc, and ppt content in line with Universal Design for Learning concepts. Let your students know about this tool by adding a statement to your syllabus:

(sample)" Take advantage of the ReadSpeaker 'Listen' and 'DocReader' buttons to enhance your understanding and comprehension of the materials within the content area. Listening to text read aloud is shown to improve reading comprehension."

Share a link to the ReadSpeaker Quick-Start Guide and video.

Creative ways to utilize Zoom for student engagement and collaboration:

- "Virtual" Office Hours With the majority of summer courses conducted online, Zoom enables you to hold office hours remotely. Post a link in D2L letting students know that you will be available at a set time. Download the Zoom mobile app so you won't be tied to your computer!
- Paper and Research Reviews Use Zoom's "Share Screen" feature to provide real-time feedback during thesis development. Use in conjunction with D2L's anonymous Assignment submission to provide feedback in a group session.
- **Exam Review** Host a Zoom session for test prep; moderate a student-led dsicussion, or lead the review yourself.
- **Group Work** Encourage students to collaborate using Zoom. Share the <u>Zoom support web page</u> and encourage students to establish their Zoom- Basic accounts.
