Job and Internship Searching – Ecology and Environmental Biology

Things to start doing right away in college:

- Maintain a resume throughout your college career. Keep track of any experience acquired, paid
 or unpaid a significant project done for a course may count. Keep track of any field, lab, or
 computing skills acquired through jobs or through courses. Keeping lab manuals really helps
 with this.
- Get to know your professors this leads to not only good friendships and a rewarding college experience, but also opportunities for research, and good reference letters down the road.
- Start looking at job postings early, even freshman year! You may have to start by volunteering for a faculty project or during your summer breaks. Eventually, you want to get solid field positions or internships (preferably paid) outside of the university setting. Experience is incredibly important for eventual employment in these fields. The more you read and look at job postings, the better you will understand the job market. This allows you to tailor your academic plan and summer employment to best position you for getting the job.

Joining a national organization as a student member is not expensive, and looks great on your resume. It shows that you are interested in and connected to the scientific community in your field of interest. Look up the ones on your area of interest, join them, and take advantage of their job boards. You need to try different search terms to find the jobs you want. Many summer, internship, or bachelor's level positions will most include the term *technician* or *intern*. Applying through this site can be strange and time consuming. Best to establish a profile for use in the future, as these jobs open for very brief windows of time.
