#### **EDUCATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (EAP)**

The State Education Assistance Program (EAP) can pay up to \$3,746, per semester (total of 10 semesters) if you are a PA resident with a <u>6 year Guard contract</u> and attending a PA school. You can also use EAP with Federal Tuition Assistance (FTA) or Montgomery GI Bill - Selected Reserve (MGIB-SR), Chapter 1606.

Up to \$3,746/semester; 6-yr obligation to PANG and must apply all other applicable benefits first (FTA, GI Bill, etc). In combination with other programs, cannot exceed 100% of actual costs. Can be used for ALL costs associated with attending an institution of higher learning (tuition, fees, books, room and board, etc) but cannot exceed 100% of costs.

## Am I Eligible?

To be considered for the Pennsylvania National Guard Education Assistance Program (EAP), you must:

- Be a resident (bona fide domiciliary) of Pennsylvania
- Be enrolled in a degree- or certificate-granting program of study at an approved Pennsylvania institution

### **How Much Can I Expect to Receive?**

If you fail to honor the service commitment with the Pennsylvania National Guard, you must repay your total EAP award amount, plus interest.
