

Student Teacher Parking Permits

Residence Hall students on block or who are student teaching face a unique problem regarding parking on campus. Student teachers frequently leave in the early morning hours before dawn. For those students living in University-owned residence halls, this may mean walking a considerable distance in early morning darkness and during bad weather. To compound this problem, student teachers often must carry materials needed for the day's school activities.

To help alleviate these problems, and to promote the academic mission of the University, Public Safety is introducing "Student Teacher" permits beginning this fall.

A Student Teacher Permit is valid:

- In any resident student lot, 24 hours a day.
- In any on-campus lot, between 4:30 PM and 8:00 AM. This is significant because all commuter student lots and employee lots are generally posted "no overnight parking" 2AM-6AM. Student teachers will therefore be able to park in lots near their residence hall overnight without being ticketed for a "no overnight parking" offense.

To be eligible:

- The student must live in on-campus residence halls.
- The student must pay the permit fee
- The student must come to public safety during normal business hours and show proof of student teaching/block status.
