McAfee Virex for the Macintosh Systems

I. How to tell what version of McAfee Virex you have or need:

- If your MAC was purchased after June of 2007, then you have a new INTEL Core Duo processor and should be running McAfee Virex version 8.6.
- If your MAC is running OS X 10.4.6 or higher you should also be running McAfee Virex version 8.6.
- If your MAC running OS X 10.4.0 - OS X 10.4.5 you should be using McAfee Virex version 8.5
- If your MAC running OS X 10.3.x or lower you should be using McAfee Virex version 7.7
- If you do not have a Virex icon  in your dock, you will have to look in your Application Folder.



Click on Virex at the top of the screen and choose "About Virex" and this screen opens:

II. **System Requirements:**

✓ **McAfee VirusScan for Mac 8.6**

- Mac OS X 10.4.6 or later, Mac OS X 10.5 or later)
- Intel or PowerPC based Macintosh
- 512 MB RAM
- Minimum of 45MB of disk space

✓ **McAfee VirusScan for Mac 8.5**

- Mac OS X 10.4.0 - 10.4.5
- Intel or PowerPC based Macintosh
- 128 MB RAM

✓ **McAfee Virex 7.7 for Macintosh**

- Apple Mac OS X v10.2.6 or later, Mac OS X v10.3.3 or later, Mac OS X v10.4 or later
- 266 MHZ G3 (or greater)
- 128 MB RAM

III. Installation Procedures: (same for either version)

1. Download appropriate Virex program for you Mac:

2. You will be prompted for your iClarion username/password. Type in your username and password (see examples below) and then click the "Log In" button.

3. The download will start automatically. Press "Continue".



4. Close the download box and go to the Desktop. Double click the Virex folder. Click **the Virex.pkg icon**.
5. Click **Continue** to the next four buttons and **Agree** to the installation.

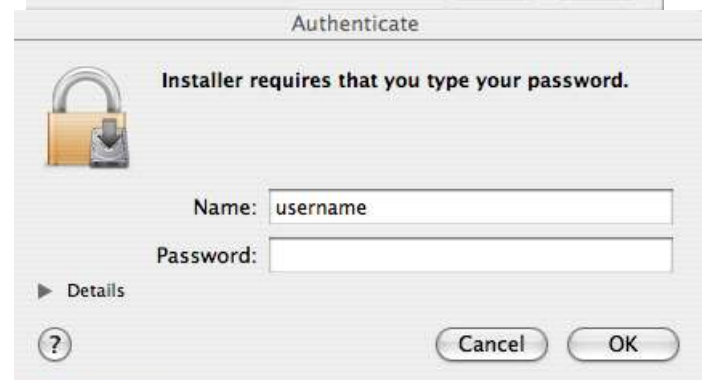
6. Click **Continue** to install.



7. Click **Upgrade**



8. Enter your **MAC** username and password.



9. The installation will start automatically; click **Restart** to finish the install.

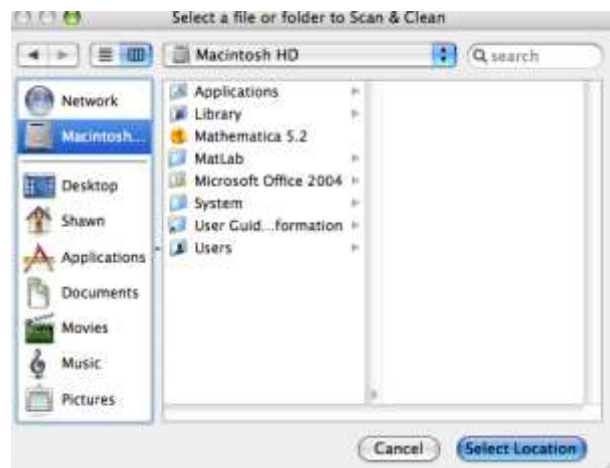


10. After the reboot you can move the Virex folder on the desktop to the trash can.

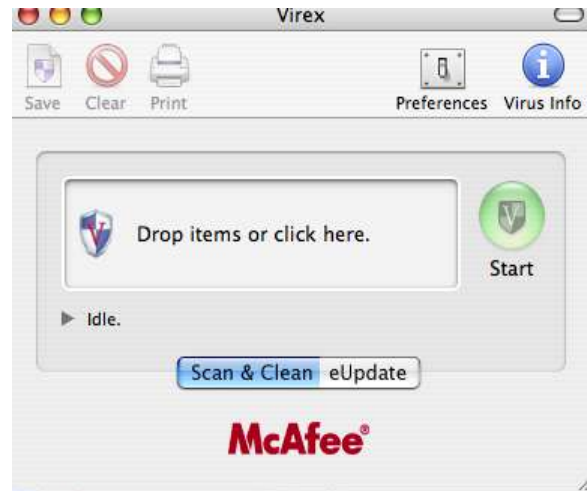
11. To access the program, double click the Macintosh HD icon on the desktop and then the Applications Folder.



12. Find the Virex application and double click. Before running a scan check to make sure that your program is up to date. You can do this by selecting the eUpdate button.



13. To run a scan of your system, double click inside the box "Drop items or click here". (see above image)



14. On the left side of the next screen select the Macintosh HD and click the Select Location and press the Start button.
