Financial Assistance for International Students

Financial assistance in the form of partial tuition waivers is offered to students at Clarion University through the international assistantship program. This assistance is renewable each year provided financial need is demonstrated and academic performance meets required level. Students who receive assistantships are required to make significant contributions in the area of international education.

In addition to the amount covered by the International Assistantship, students need to provide sufficient funds to cover the balance of university fees and all living costs. In order to receive an I-20 form, evidence of these funds must be on file with the university.

If you meet all admission requirements, have sufficient supplemental funds, and are interested in being considered for an International Assistantship, please complete the "Application for International Assistantship" form and return it to the Office of International Programs, Clarion University of PA, Clarion, PA 16214.

Students who are planning to pursue master's degrees at Clarion are strongly encouraged to apply for a Graduate Assistantship (GA) through the department of their major. A GA provides a stipend in addition to covering partial tuition fees.

Please understand that it is virtually impossible to earn self-support and /or university expenses by employment while enrolled as a student here. Permission to accept off-campus employment must be obtained from the U.S. Immigration Service, and application for this is considered for approval only after a student has been enrolled one year and has satisfactory evidence that the employment is necessary due to an unforeseen change in economic status since enrollment.

Although international students are eligible to work on campus, employment opportunities are limited, and can not be guaranteed prior to student's arrival.
