DIRECTIONS FOR FILLING OUT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

General - Many scholarships are available to students and prospective students of Venango Campus. They are made available from businesses, service organizations, local residents, the faculty of Venango Campus, and the Clarion University Foundation. Each of the scholarship donors set certain criteria for their scholarship(s). For your convenience, the Venango Campus Scholarship Committee requires you to submit only one application. We will make a determination of all the scholarships for which you are eligible and consider you for all of them.

Additional scholarships are offered through many of the university's departments. We encourage you to explore additional scholarship opportunities through the department of your major as well as other scholarships available in your community.

Guidelines for awarding scholarships. The Scholarship Committee considers the following when awarding scholarships:

- Academic achievement
- Extracurricular activities
- Financial need
- Professional goals
- Criteria specified by the scholarship sponsor
- Majority of credits scheduled at the Venango Campus
- One scholarship per student per year

NOTE: In some circumstances the requirements of these rules may be waived.

Please be as complete with your information as possible. A partially completed application will negatively affect your chances of a scholarship.

Be honest. Fill in every blank. If you feel an item needs further explanation, do so on the back of the application. If you don't know an answer to a question, say "I don't know." Call your high school if you have forgotten your SAT score, ACT Score or your class rank. **If you are a current student**, check your iClarion portal under Student Services for your degree audit which lists your cumulative GPA.

Observe the deadline – Your application must be received by the deadline noted on these instructions and the application. We will notify you as soon as possible of the committee's decision concerning your application.
