The mix of technical skills, general education, and business courses prepares graduates of the Industrial Technology program for a variety of career opportunities and jobs that include high performance work team leaders, foremen, or superintendents.



The hallmark of the Clarion University graduate of the Industrial Technology program is his or her ability to do something, not simply know about something. Combining hands-on training with classroom learning at Clarion University—Venango Campus, the two-year program leads to an Associate of Applied Science in Industrial Technology (AAS-IT) degree.

Through partnerships with certified, licensed or accredited technical education providers, Clarion offers a range of technical concentrations in an ever-changing mix to prepare the workforce



to meet employer requirements. Concentrations range from machining and lumber grading to electromechanical, to electric utility technology and network administrator.

The program is flexible and dynamic, allowing students to take their technical training before, during, or after their Clarion University coursework. Students may complete the program on a full- or part-time basis. Adult learners with prior training from an accepted technical education program, including high school or military programs, may be awarded college credit and complete the program in as little as one year. Flexible class schedules, including evening courses and weekend technical training, make it easier for working students to obtain their degree. Furthermore, a variety of financial aid and scholarship opportunities are available to students.
