Smart Classroom Quick-Start Guide

Getting Started

- 1. Locate the device port wall plate (*Figure 1*). The device port connects your laptop to the overhead projector.
- 2. Locate the controller on the wall, sometimes behind the sliding front doors (Figure 2). The controller will turn on/off the projector.
- 3. Connect the laptop using a standard VGA monitor cable or HDMI cable.


4. Turn projector on using the display buttons on the wall mounted controller. (Figure 2)

- 5. Select the source (Laptop 1 or 2, DVD, HDMI or VGA, or Document Camera.) Source button options will vary from room to room. (Figure 2)
- 6. Optional: Connect the network cable to the white slot located on the network connection box, if needed. See Figure 3
- 7. To adjust room audio as needed, use the volume control to adjust the sound levels. There are speakers located in the ceiling. (Figure 2)
