D2L Course Purge

In November and March, an upcoming course purge was announced in keeping with the PASSHE course retention policy. The schedule for the purge of D2L courses in semesters beginning Summer 2010 through Spring 2012 is displayed below. Please see the proposed timings and review the documentation on how to backup your course using Course Export.

View the <u>reference guide</u> to compare what IS and IS NOT included in an export file.

The course deletion process will begin June 1, starting with courses in the Summer, Fall and Winter 2010 semesters. The purge plans include deleting courses for a calendar year according to the schedule below:

2010 Courses: June 1 : All Summer, Fall, Winter **2011 Courses: July 5**: All Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter

2012 Courses: Aug 1: Only Spring 2012

Blackboard Collaborate Upgrade



Blackboard Collaborate (aka Collaborate

Classic) web conferencing tool will be upgraded to the newest version - Collaborate Ultra - over the summer. This new version introduces a more intuitive interface making it easier for students and faculty to interact in real time, or create and view recordings.

As we phase in the new version, and for training purposes, users will see **Collaborate Ultra** within the Communication menu of the D2L nav bar beginning mid-April. Starting Summer I, the new version

Turnitin Launches Feedback Studio and Integration Updates

Turnitin has released a major product upgrade featuring a new look when assessing papers in Turnitin as well as a version update within D2L. Both upgrades will be enabled **July 12**.

Turnitin Feedback Studio offers all the features of Turnitin Classic, but with a simplified, more intuitive look and feel when opening students' papers. To experience the new grading interface, explore **Feedback Studio** by visiting <u>Turnitin's interactive demo site</u>. Instructors will be able to toggle between Feedback Studio and Turnitin Classic (<u>instructions</u>). Students will also experience this new and improved interface.



More <u>details are available</u> on our web page under 3rd party tools.



D2L Discussions

D2L has changed the way instructors create and assess group discussions. A new workflow makes it easier to create restricted group topics using the option to "Create one topic with threads separated by group".

In addition, only one grade item is required making assessing group topics faster. See the new <u>workflow documentation</u> for screen shots and instructions. The new groups topic option will be available with the April continuous delivery updates on or about April 21.

There are no changes to workflow for students.

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
