

6-Year Graduation Rate for Students Pursuing Bachelor's Degrees who were Recipients of a Pell Grant and/or Subsidized Stafford (Direct) Loan

This chart shows the percentage of full-time, first-time, bachelor-degree-seeking students who began their studies in the Cohort Year listed below, and who received a degree or award within 150% of "Normal Time to Completion" for their program (6 years).

The items in this report correspond to data elements collected by the IPEDS Web-based Data Collection System's Graduation Rate Survey (GRS). A recipient will be defined as anyone who receives and uses these awards anytime within their first year. Students who received both a Federal Pell Grant and a subsidized Stafford Loan are reported in the "Recipients of a Federal Pell Grant" column.
