Testing Information-Student Responsibilities

It is highly recommended that students discuss with their advisor any CLEP examination they plan to take, to insure that the time, energy and money for the exam(s) are not in vain. As a general rule, students may not substitute a CLEP examination for a course in their major. **All CLEP examinations are administered as a computer-based test (CBT) at Venango College of Clarion University.**

EXAMS:

The CLEP test is usually administered at 9 a.m. All CLEP testing will take place in Room 311 Montgomery Hall.

STUDY GUIDES:

Study guides can be downloaded from the College Board Web site at www.collegeboard.com/clep. Most public libraries have some version of the study guide or handbook to the CLEP exam, which may also be purchased. The handbook contains sample test questions for each exam and lists recommended textbooks for each test. If you still have questions after reviewing the above materials, please feel free to call Kyle Vickers, 814 676 6591, ext. 1344. You can take a maximum of two tests per testing day. There is a **six month** waiting period to retake any failed CLEP exams.

COST:

Each CLEP exam costs \$80.00. CLEP® exam payments must be made by test-takers online through the My Account registration portal. Cost per exam is \$80.00. Administration fee \$20 made payable to Clarion University.

Service Fee is \$20.00. This fee must be paid by check payable to Clarion University of Pennsylvania and is non refundable should you not show up on the day of the test. DO NOT COMBINE the CLEP fee of \$80.00 with this service fee. These are two separate agencies and two payments must be issued.

Please note that there is a maximum of 11 participants per test date. Note: All applications must be received at Venango College, ATTN: Continuing Education, 1801 West First Street, Oil City, PA 16301 no later than one week prior to the test date in order to hold your seat for the testing.
