PREFACE

The Clarion University Archives, housed in Carlson Library on the Clarion University campus, serve as the central repository for information and records created by, for, and about the University and its constituency. It exists to identify, collect, and preserve records of enduring value to the Clarion University community and to deliver a useful information service to its members as well as to the public at large. The aim of the Archives is to achieve the ultimate goal of advancing the educational and research mission of the University as an institution and of supporting inquiries about those who have built and sustained it.

Archival collections, unless restricted, are available to members of the Clarion University community and outside researchers. A complete archives collecting policy and services / use policy is available from the archivist. Researchers wishing to access this collection or other archival collections should make an appointment with the archivist before visiting the Clarion University Archives.

INTRODUCTION

The records of the *Center for the Study of Rural Librarianship*, henceforth referred to as CSRL, were received in the Clarion University Archives in August 2008. The core collection and related journals totals 4 cubic feet. The collection was transferred to the Archives by Dr. Bernard Vavrek. Dr. Vavrek, the coordinator / director of CSRL, was a faculty member in the Library Science Department from 1971 until his retirement in Summer 2008.

The bulk of the collection consists of CSRL publications (such as journals, conference proceedings, and newsletters), and brochures documenting the agendas for CSRL and CSRL-related workshops and conferences. The records are open for research without restrictions, under conditions of the Archives' services / use policy (available from the archivist.) The suggested citation to the collection is: "Center for the Study of Rural Librarianship, Clarion University Archives, Carlson Library, Clarion University of Pennsylvania."

ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

The quotations in this section are available from a brochure about CSRL available in folder # 1.1

The CSRL was organized in 1978 by the faculty of the *School of Library Media and Information Science*, as the department was referred to at that time. Dr. Bernard Vavrek, a department faculty member from 1971 – 2008, served continuously as the director / coordinator of CSRL. The stated goal of CSRL was "to identify needs and to extend current knowledge relative to the nature and role of rural libraries"

whether they be public, school, academic, special, or corporate libraries, or library systems / networks including small libraries. CSRL "developed out of a particular concern for library services in areas geographically isolated from spheres of influence generated by metropolitan library systems." At its founding, the objectives of CSRL were: "1) To stimulate imaginative thinking relative to rural library services; 2) To identify problems endemic with rural library services – for those being served and those who are unserved; 3) To provide consultative services in designing new service patterns in rural libraries; 4) To conduct and / or coordinate research relative to identifiable library problems; 5) To stimulate continuing education; 6) To coordinate physical and human resources which could be lent to analyze library services; 7) To collect data relevant to the needs of rural libraries."

CSRL's primary activities were to organize continuing education workshops and conferences, to offer graduate level courses in rural library studies & internship opportunities in rural libraries, to participate in research programs and projects (funded by the *H.W. Wilson Foundation, National Endowment for the Humanities, Pennsylvania Humanities Council*, and *Pennsylvania State University*), to publish materials focusing on rural librarianship (bibliographies, newsletters, conference proceedings, journals), and to provide speakers for conferences and workshops held by groups outside of CSRL.

The CSRL disbanded in 2008 with the retirement of Dr. Vavrek, with the intention that its activities would be continued (beginning in 2009) by the *Association for Rural and Small Libraries* and the *Association of Bookmobile and Outreach Services*. These two entities were founded by the CSRL, but are no longer affiliated with the University. In the final 2008 issues of *Bookmobile and Outreach Services* and *Rural Libraries* (CSRL journals), Dr. Vavrek writes, "The intention in helping to parent both of these entities was always with the idea that they would become independent from Clarion University and provide continuity. The *H. W. Wilson Foundation*, which has been a supporter of the CSRL over many years, provided the original funding to organize both associations in 2002."

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection is composed of five series: *brochures*, *publications*, *correspondence*, *coordinator's activities*, and *miscellaneous*. The collection contains materials dated from 1978 – 2008, with the bulk of materials in the *brochures* and *publications* series. The *brochures* series is particularly helpful in documenting the agendas for workshops and conferences presented by or sponsored by the CSRL.

SERIES DESCRIPTION

Brochures (Series 1) – 8 folders

This series contains CSRL-related brochures of various types:

Folder 1.1 - Background Information (circa 1978 - 1982) – Describe the goals, objectives and activities of CSRL and describe graduate level library science courses pertaining to rural / small libraries.

Folder 1.2 - *Conferences / Workshops* (1978 – 2006) – These brochures are programs, registration forms, and announcements for conferences and workshops sponsored by or in cooperation with CSRL.

Folder 1.3 - Rural Libraries and the Humanities (1981 – 1983) – Informational brochures and conference programs / registration forms for a special series of workshops held over a two-year period from Nov. 1981 – Nov. 1983. They were funded through a grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities.

Folder 1.4 - Institute for the Development of Information Technology in Rural Communities (1997 – 1999) – Programs and registration forms for conferences sponsored by the Institute for the Development of Information Technology in Rural Communities, Clarion University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Vavrek served as the director of this Institute.

Folder 1.5 - Business Information Services of the Clarion District Library Association (1984) – Informational brochures about Business Information Services and workshop advertisements for workshops held by Business Information Services in cooperation with CSRL.

Folder 1.6 - *Rural Adult Literacy Program* (1987) – Brochures describing the *Rural Adult Literacy Center*, formed in 1987 through legislation proposed by Representative David R. Wright (D-63) and supported by an appropriation from the Pennsylvania State Legislature.
