### If We Don't Have It...We'll Get It!



Can't find the information you need in the library or among our many databases? Let us know and we will do all that we can to get it.

If it's a book that you are looking for and it's not in our collection, check out [E-ZBorrow](#), an interlibrary borrowing service for books. You can find it under the "Library Services" column on the [Libraries](#) home page. E-Z Borrow searches the catalogs of more than 50 libraries, including those of large research libraries such as Pitt, Penn State, and Carnegie Mellon. Requested titles often arrive at Clarion University Libraries within five days and you will receive an e-mail alerting you that the book is ready to pick up at the library.

**Students:** Your E-Z Borrow Patron Login is 9 + your Clarion ID number.  
[Get Help](#) in determining your Clarion ID number.

**Faculty and Staff:** Your E-Z Borrow Patron Login is Leading zeroes + your employee ID number.  
(Use enough preceding zeroes to create a nine-digit number.)

Your employee ID number can be found on your pay stub.

If you can't find what you are looking for through E-Z Borrow (or if it is an article or other type of item that you need), please use our regular InterLibrary Loan (ILL) borrowing service that uses ILLiad software to facilitate the process.

repeated entry of routine information. It also allows the user to track requests throughout the entire process. When the item arrives, you are notified via email. If the item is an article or book chapter that has been scanned, you are provided with a Web link to view, print, or save the item for up to 30 days.

To use E-Z Borrow and ILLiad InterLibrary Loan and borrowing services, you must know your Clarion iPortal Login and Password as well as your Student or Employee ID Number. ## Computer Tip: Printing & More...Eagle Dollars Work For You!



The [Eagle Dollars](#) program, offered through the ID Office in Egbert Hall, is a debit account that allows you to use your student ID card to make purchases on campus.


Eagle Dollars can be used at the university book store, vending machines, washers and dryers, all food service locations, and printing in the computer labs (including the Carlson and Suhr Libraries). Now, you can also use your ID card to pay library fines and fees at Carlson Library!

You can set up your Eagle Dollars account with as little as \$25 and add money anytime with cash, check, or credit card. Eagle dollars can also be added in smaller increments at the *Valueport* in the lower level of the Gemmell Student Complex.

Eagle Dollars aren't just for students! Employees can also add money to their ID cards.
