Open Access Journals Added



Did you know that you have access to more than 33,000 journals through the libraries of Clarion University?


All but a few hundred of these are available in electronic form, which means that you can access them from almost anywhere when you authenticate as a Clarion University

student or faculty member through the Libraries' Website.

In addition to the 24,736 titles that we pay for, the Libraries provide easy access to more than 8,000 open access journals. These are peer-reviewed journals that are available without the end-user paying the cost of a subscription. They - and all of our journals - are easy to find through our [A-Z Journal List](#) or through one of our full-text or indexing databases, such as those from EBSCOHost.

Recently we added several hundred new open access journals in the fields of education, library science, physics, and several other subject disciplines. Check them out or contact one of our librarians if you have questions.

Computer Tip: Watermarks In Less Than A Minute

We've all seen documents with watermarks in the background - whether it's a word like "confidential" or a graphic - it's behind the main document and a much lighter


shade or washout of colors.

Adding a watermark to a document doesn't have to involve a lot of work. Actually, it only takes a quick minute to have a whatever you need as a watermark on your page, so let's take a look at where watermarks are tucked away in Word 2007 & 2010.

Start on the **Page Layout** tab of the Ribbon.



Click the **Watermark** button to access a variety of ready-made text watermarks or choose **Custom Watermark** to use a graphic or your own text.



As you can see, simply **select the type of watermark** then either select the picture file or enter your custom text and set formatting.

Click **Apply** to preview your watermark and click **OK** when you're satisfied with the results. Voila! The watermark done!

Want to remove your watermark ? No problem... return to the **Page Layout** tab, **Watermark** button and choose **Remove Watermark** at the bottom.

Go ahead, watermark it, you've got a minute to spare.
