

Computer Tip: Paint Your Excel Spreadsheet

In this example, cell **A1** is **bold**, *italic*, and a different color. There could be several other cells that require the same formatting. Instead of going to each one and reformatting it, use the **Format Painter**.



1. Select the cell that will be used as the example for the other cells; in this case it is cell **A1**.

2. Click the **Format Painter** on the toolbar. (Click it once to use it once, double click it to get unlimited used until it is clicked again).

3. Move through your sheet and click any cell that you want to look like the first cell you clicked (**A1**). Each cell clicked will be **bold**, *italic* and the same color as **A1**.
