

Dear Clarion student:

The following information will clarify your course status and the use of D2L course shells.

(1). Posted to the university strike information page, as well as to the main page of the D2L site, is a link to the “course status list.” Each course listing indicates whether it is “meeting” or “not meeting.” Students should scroll through the list to find their courses and determine if they are meeting. Students should still attend their Thursday courses. By Friday evening, the list should accurately indicate all of the courses that are meeting or not meeting, including all online courses.

(2). Effective immediately, all D2L course shells have been activated for students to continue to progress in their work. Faculty may have removed some materials from the course site; however, the materials that remain are available for students to use. This includes online courses as well as any D2L sites that accompany face-to-face courses.

You should check the status page at least once each day (preferably in the evening). In addition, while you may suspect a course may not be meeting, you should still attend at least one course meeting before you are officially informed that a course may not be meeting.

Finally, continue to check your university e-mail daily for announcements and updates.
