## Here's what to bring to live in campus suites...





- Television and coaxial cables
- Fan
- Bluetooth headphones/stereo
- Computer (Wi-Fi-accessible)/cables to hard wire connection to landline
- Linens (towels, sheets for standard twin bed, blankets, pillows and comforter/bedspread)
- Alarm clock
- Refrigerator (4 cu. ft. max) and microwave (700 watt max):
  Suites on Main Shared = 1 per room

Suites on Main Private = 1 per student Hilltop 4-person = 1 per room Hilltop 2-person = 1 per suite

- Personal items and toiletries
- Medical kit (bandages, thermometer, over-the-counter medicine, hand sanitizer)
- School supplies
- Trash can
- Desk lamp (not halogen)
- Photos of family and friends
- Shower curtain: Suites on Main 40"W x 72"L Hilltop Suites 60"W x 72"L
- Cleaning supplies and toilet paper
- Toilet plunger
- Hot pots, hot air popcorn poppers and coffee/Keurig makers with automatic shut-offs and without exposed heating elements are permitted. All other cooking appliances are prohibited.

- Halogen lamps
- Illegal drugs/paraphernalia
- Candles/candle warmers/incense are not permitted in any residence hall (even for decorative purposes)
- Heated wax products
- Alcohol (or empty alcohol containers)
- Explosives
- Waterbeds
- Firearms/BB guns/paint guns
- Metal-tipped darts
- Non-grounded electrical connectors
- Electric heaters
- Heated blankets
- Portable washers and dryers
- Wireless routers
- Live decorations (trees, hay, wreaths)
- Hoverboards
- No pets except fish (10-gallon tank or less), service animal, or support animal registered with Disability Support Services
- Cooking appliances other than microwaves, hot pots, hot air popcorn poppers and coffee/ Keurig makers with automatic shut-offs and without exposed heating elements
