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## Zoom Cloud Recording Retention Policy



Recall that in May, we announced a NEW Zoom cloud recording retention policy to effectively manage available storage. In early July, Zoom cloud recordings older than 180 days began automatically moving to Zoom account holders' trash folders where they remain for 30 days. Recordings that need to be retained should be moved to One Drive or stored on a local storage drive. Please see "[Manage and Archive Zoom Cloud Recordings](#)".

**PLEASE NOTE:** The 180-day policy will be a rolling deletion. Each day, additional cloud recordings will be moved to the trash if they are older than 180 days. In your Zoom web portal under "Recordings", users will see the number of days until a cloud recording is moved to "trash". Users will receive an email notification from "Zoom <no-reply@zoom.us>" 7 days before permanent deletion. Please contact [ltcsupport](#) with any questions.
