BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY

The Medical Technology Program includes an academic preparation of three years at Clarion and a 12-month course of clinical study in a hospital-based school of medical technology accredited by the National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory Sciences, (NAACLS), (32 semester hours). Upon successful completion of two years of prescribed courses at Clarion, the student is eligible to apply for admission to the hospital school. Although application is made through the office of the coordinator of medical technology at Clarion, acceptance is at the discretion of the staff of the clinical school. Clinical school spaces are limited, and admission to the Medical Technology Program at Clarion does not guarantee admission to the clinical school year. Clarion University maintains affiliations with eight clinical schools; students may apply to accredited, non-affiliated schools also.

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN MEDICAL IMAGING

Students choose between the radiologic technology or ultrasound (sonography) concentration. Both concentrations are designed as two-plus-two programs. The programs have an academic preparation of two years (60 semester hours of science and general education) and students can choose to complete these courses at either the Clarion campus or Venango campus. The radiologic technology concentration continues with a two-year program of clinical study (60 semester hours) at one of several <u>JRCERT</u>- accredited, hospital-based schools of radiologic technology. The ultrasound concentration continues with a two-year program of clinical study in sonography (60 semester hours) at Great Lakes Institute of Technology.

Under this unique model, you complete general education and business courses through Clarion University, either on campus or online, and the technical component of the degree through licensed, certified, accredited, and/or otherwise approved technical education providers. Graduates receive an Associate or Bachelor of Applied Science degree from Clarion University.

For the Associate's degree, you will complete 30-33 credit hours (one year if you attend Clarion full-time) of specified coursework with Clarion University prior to field training with one of our technical education providers. At one of our technical education providers, you will complete a concentration in either Administrative Technology or Industrial Technology.
