Learning Outcomes

After successfully completing this program, students will:

1. Communicate in Spanish at an intermediate level demonstrating their ability to create with the language when talking about familiar topics related to daily life.
2. Produce sentence-level language, ranging from discrete sentences to strings of sentences, typically in present time.
3. Be understood by interlocutors who are accustomed to dealing with non-native Spanish speakers.
4. Acquire and demonstrate skills necessary to analyze and compare cultural products, and practices of the Latino cultures in the U.S. with other cultures in the U.S.
5. Identify and analyze cultural products and situate those products within a broad historical framework.
