# Student Support & Hospitality Package

Fall semester: Mid-August to end of December  
Spring semester: January to end of May

The Student Support & Hospitality Package is designed for exchange students who have applied either for one semester or the whole academic year at the *Université Catholique de Lille*. It is tailored to provide a welcoming environment and an excellent study/life balance during your time in Lille. This is the perfect package for your time abroad.

The basic package includes your welcome on arrival at Lille, accommodation, and continuing orientation and information throughout the semester. Optional modules add even more to your experience: a pre-immersion Intensive French course, cultural outings and day trips, a comprehensive insurance package, a campus meal plan, and a local transportation pass.

## Basic Package

#### > Welcome on arrival & Orientation

Welcome at Lille Europe train Station and transfer to your dorm/apartment. A staff member will be available on campus for continuing orientation and information throughout the semester.

#### > Accommodation

**Option 1-** Dorm on campus: enjoy a single room in a dorm on our campus, voted one of the most beautiful in France and take advantage of a cozy atmosphere and daily interaction with French students. Shared kitchen and lounge. Shared bathroom on each floor. Wifi available. Personal fridge in each room. French breakfast provided on weekdays.

**Option 2-** Studio apartment downtown: benefit from a comfortable studio apartment located just one minute's walk from the shopping center, 5 minutes' walk from the station and a 15-minute bus ride from the campus. Private kitchen and bathroom. Wifi available.



## 4 Optional Modules

### > Meal Plan & Transportation Pass • 700 €/semester

This includes half-board at the university restaurant, on week days. (5 meals/week)

An unlimited local transportation pass is provided with access to any bus, subway, and tram within the metropolitan Lille area.

### > Comprehensive Insurance Package • 370 €/semester

(see detailed annex)

For students who don't benefit from insurance coverage while in France, the comprehensive insurance package provides health and civil liability. It enables refund of all medical and hospital expenses.

### > Pre-Immersion Intensive French • 550 €/semester (fall only)

The objective of this 2-week pre-immersion intensive French course is to prepare students from Beginner to Advanced language levels for academic university programs, as well as an introduction to French culture.

The program is comprised of 4 hours of class each morning, plus 18.5 hours of conversation during the session (50 hours of contact time) plus 1 or 2 hours of personal study per day for maximum improvement. Grammar, oral comprehension, and both written and oral expression will be studied in class.

### > Cultural Outings & Day trips • 500 €/semester

- Architectural and historical visit of Lille (walking tour)
- 4 museum visits
- 4 other cultural outings (theatre, opera, concerts)
- 2 day trips

Other day trips offered for an extra cost.

The Comprehensive Insurance Package includes medical care and pharmacy, hospital costs, optical and dental costs, civil liability, personal accident insurance, counselling and medical hotline.

Students can either go to the University Medical Center or to any private medical practitioner of the French Social Security System. We hold a list of English speaking practitioners. The average price of a medical consultation (GP) is €25.

Our University Medical Center (CPSU) is located on the campus and consists of medical practitioners, a gynecologist and a psychologist.
