

The Louis D. Adelson Venango Student Housing Scholarship Endowment

This Scholarship fund was established by Mr. Louis D. Adelson to help students at Clarion University-Venango Campus achieve their educational goals. Mr. Adelson, assistant professor of computer information science, joined the Clarion faculty in 1986. He shares a long-standing commitment to the Venango Campus and its role in changing lives and making a lasting contribution to the region.

Eligibility

Priority in awarding the Adelson Scholarship will be given to students who demonstrate financial need and who are (in order of preference):

- a. disabled veterans enrolled full-time;
- b. veterans at large enrolled full-time;
- c. non-traditional students (defined as students not moving directly from high school to college) enrolled full-time; and,
- d. other students enrolled full-time.

Scholars will reside in the Clarion University Foundation, Inc. (or subsequent owner) student apartments at Venango College-Clarion University throughout each semester they receive support.

Students must remain in good academic standing by achieving a 2.0 grade point average to be considered for the award in subsequent years.
